TOXIC – Causes health problems to humans and wildlife, such as pesticides, antifreeze.

FLAMMABLE – Ignites or catches fire easily, such as gasoline, paint thinner.

CORROSIVE – Eats away at other materials, such as strong acids, drain cleaner.

REACTIVE – Reacts violently with water, other chemicals, air or is shock sensitive, such as chlorine bleach, pool cleaner.

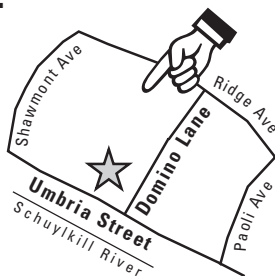
