Effective Monday, January 7, 2019, there will be a change in the sanitation collection day for residences within and along the boundaries of Frankford Ave to Aramingo Ave from Norris St to York St. The collection day will change **from Friday to Thursday** for residents who receive City trash and recycling services.

The change in day will improve the quality and efficiency of our sanitation services in this area including:

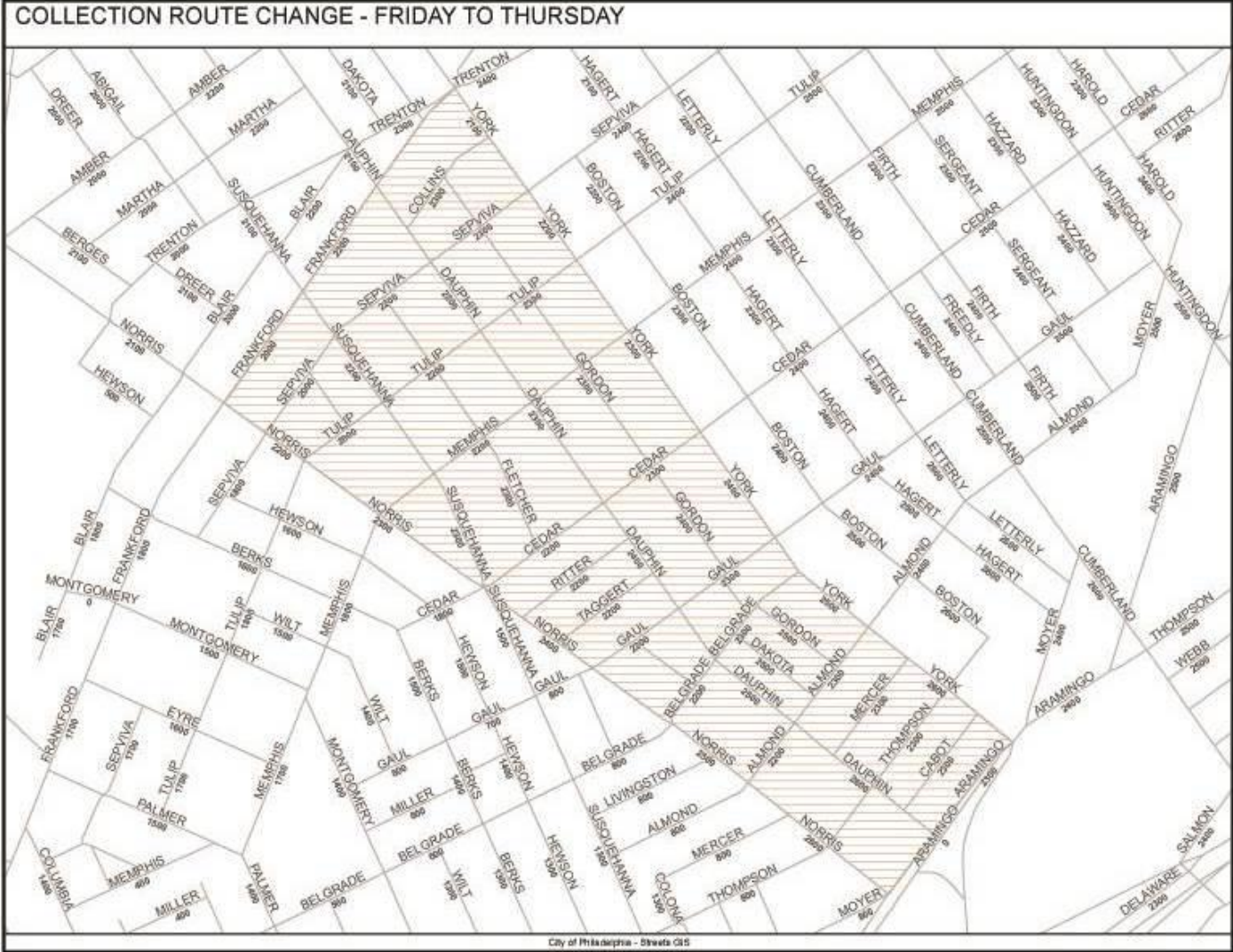
- Reduce the amount of time that trash is on the street
